

A registered application provider identifier (RID) is assigned to entities providing the components that make up an application in a card.

1 RID application

According to ISO/IEC 7816-5:2004, **an applicant for an RID** meeting the criteria for approval as defined in ISO/IEC 7816-5:2004 section 4.1.2 and not meeting the criteria for rejection as defined in ISO/IEC 7816-5:2004 section 4.1.3 shall provide NBN with a completed **"Registration form for a registered application provider identifier of category A"** (Annex A of ISO/IEC 7816-5:2004). Be aware that,

- An applicant shall not already have an RID. Exceptions are subject to decision by the RMG (registration management group).

2 Registration fee

NBN charges a fee of EUR 726 (including 21% VAT). The fee is to be transferred to the following bank account:

3 Getting the RID

Within 30 days of receipt of the registration fee and positive verification of the application, the application is sent to the international Registration Authority for further treatment. Once the application is approved by the Registration Authority and NBN has received the assigned RID, the applicant is informed.

When an applicant becomes the owner of a RID, the responsibilities listed in ISO/IEC 7816-5:2004 section 4.3 become effective.
